*Cocca Wins Wire to Wire***

**Galloway, NJ** — The final round of the 2010 IJGT at Seaview Dolce Resort concluded Sunday under clear skies and cool temperatures on the Pines course in Galloway, NJ. Located just outside of Atlantic City, the Pines course is a traditional American layout with tree lined fairways and a plethora of bunkers which makes consistent ball striking a must at this IJGT event.



In the Boys 16-19 Division, Matthew Hardman of Gettysburg, PA fired a final round of 74 under difficult conditions to take home the first place trophy. Hardman, who trailed the overnight leader by three strokes heading into Sunday, played consistent in the cool and windy conditions in his victory. Finishing in a tie for second place were Sean Bozuk of Burlington, Canada with rounds of 73 and 80 and Jacob Goldenring of Florham Park, NJ with rounds of 74 and 79, both finishing the tournament with a total of 153.

After the round, Hardman spoke about his victory; "I played pretty well this weekend, I limited my mistakes, didn't hit any sloppy shots and when I needed, I hit some golf shots." With a win at both Hershey Links and at Seaview, Matthew is looking forward to his next IJGT event.

In the Boys 13-15 Division Daniel Furman of Blue Bell, PA opened the tournament with a solid round of 72 and never looked back as he claimed the title in his respective age division. Matthew Josephs of Palisades, NY followed up his first round of 79 with a final round of 78 to secure the second place finish. Finishing alone in third place with rounds of 79 and 80 was Erik Bringsjord of Briarcliff Manor, NY.

With the Pines course putting a premium on accuracy, Daniel spoke about his rounds; "I tried to shorten my swing in order to control my shots. I was straight off the tee and I stayed out of the woods, which was key to my victory."





Curren Mody of Monmouth Junction, NJ fired a final round of even par 71 on his way to victory in the Boys U-12 Division. Mody already has victories at Blue Heron Pines, Shoregate, and Savannah Harbor this season. Taking home second place honors was recent IJGT at the Greenbrier champion Vince Palazzolo of Colts Neck, NJ with rounds of 76 and 80. Rounding out the division with scores of 79 and 78 was Davidsonville, MD native Christopher Navarro for third place.

In the Girls 15-19 Division, Bailey Cocca of Latham, NY got off to a great start after carding a score of 73 during her first round. Cocca would play steady with the lead on Sunday to take home first place honors. The second place trophy would go to Isabelle Galantino of Westbury, NY after she carded a final round of 78 which also gave her the coveted Low Final Round Belt Buckle. Finishing in third place was multiple IJGT winner Kellie Edelblut of New Hope, PA.



Fierce IJGT competitor Gabrielle Weiss of Macungie, PA took home another title with rounds of 81 and 80 in the Girls U-14 Division. Finishing alone in second place was Sarah Kokotajlo of Ewing, NJ. Sarah has two Top 3 finishes in as many weeks. In a tie for third place was Claire Serruto of Short Hills, NJ and Elizabeth Choi of Syosett, NY both finishing the tournament at 182.

Entering Sunday's final-round, players were looking to finish strong and receive the coveted IJGT Low Final Round Belt Buckle.
