Bard Dominates at Bulle Rock
Brewer Victorious

Havre de Grace, MD — The battle for the crown at Bulle Rock came to an end after Sunday's final round at Bulle Rock Golf Club. The competitors were treated to a world renowned course that has hosted five LPGA major championships and features slick greens and daunting challenges at every hole. Cloudy skies and the threat of rain could not dampen the spirits of our young golfers as many posted very impressive scores.



In the Boys 16-19 Division, Derek Bard of New Hartford, NY displayed excellent shot making and mental toughness throughout the weekend. After a first round score of one under 71, Bard was the two stroke leader heading in to the final round. Derek never relinquished the lead as he fired a 74 in the final round to finish with a two day total of 145 and first place honors. With rounds of 74 and 76, Nate Cohen of Gaithersburg, MD provided stiff competition and earned the second place trophy. Matthew Hardman of Gettysburg, PA fired a very impressive 73 in the first round and a 78 in the second round to finish with a total of 151 and the third place trophy.

Although the weekend was full of great play, the day belonged to Derek Bard and his pinpoint accuracy. After the final round, Derek had this to say; "I just tried to play my game and hit my shots." Derek definitely did this as he won his first ever IJGT tournament in the 16-19 division. "I have had a great time here at Bulle Rock and look forward to competing again soon."

In the Boys 13-15 Division Kyle Sterbinsky of Yardley, PA opened the tournament with a solid round of even par 72 and never looked back as he claimed the title in his respective age division. He fired an equally impressive 73 the second day to finish with a tournament total of 145. Scott Jaster of Bryn Mawr, PA followed up his first round score of 73 with a final round of 75 to secure the second place finish. Both Zach Stark of Livingston, NJ and William Rosenfield of Pikesville, MD finished the tournament with a total score of 162, good enough to take home third place honors.



Willis Huynh of Syosset, NY fired a great final round to leapfrog the competition and reel in the first place trophy for the Boys 12 & Under Division. Huynh posted a 79 in the first round of the tournament but finished strong with a final round 74 to record a tournament total of 153. Taking home second place honors was recent IJGT at the Penn Oaks champion Hartej Gill of Monroe



Township, NJ with rounds of 77 and 78. Rounding out the division with scores of 83 and 77 was Wilmington, DE native Ryan Rucinski, who captured third place.

Willis is no stranger to the winners circle with the IJGT and is one of the brightest young stars on the Tour. “I placed my shots really well and had a lot of fun playing with the other guys this weekend.” He also saved his best for the last round despite the rainy and wet conditions. “I didn’t change anything because of the rain, I just played my game and hoped for the best.”

In the Girls 15-19 Division, Shabril Brewer of Herndon, VA got off to a great start after carding a score of 77 during the first round. Brewer played consistent golf with the lead on Sunday and posted a score of 78 for a two day total of 155, which earned her the first place trophy. Second place was awarded to Alexandra Austin of Burke, VA after she carded rounds of 80 and 84. Finishing in third place was Bala Cynwyd, PA native Alessandra Liu after firing rounds of 79 and 87 for a tournament total of 166. In the Girls 14 & Under Division, the familiar face of Julie Luo of Herndon, VA took home the first place trophy after very impressive rounds of 89 and 95.



Entering Sunday’s final-round, players were looking to finish strong and receive the coveted IJGT Low Final Round Belt Buckle. This week’s winners were: Boys 16-19 Division, Derek Bard, 74.
