Stockl Dominates Hershey
Kim wins in thrilling fashion

Hersey, PA — Hershey Country Club was the site of this weekend's 36-hole International Junior Golf Tour (IJGT) event. Over 100 of the brightest young golfers in the world battled it out on the East Course, which provides plenty of daunting challenges and a breathtaking countryside for all to enjoy. Clear skies and seasonal temperatures were in the golfers favor as many posted very impressive total scores.



In the Boys 16-19 Division, Jacob Stockl of Clark, NJ displayed stellar shot making and mental toughness throughout the entire tournament to earn the first place trophy. Jacob fired an impressive first round of 73 and followed that up with another great round of 72 to finish with a tournament total of 145. Brandon Hartranft of Lancaster, PA also posted low scores with rounds of 76 and 72 for a total of 148, three strokes behind the leader and good enough for a second place finish. The final round of 72 was also worthy of the special 59 Belts buckle, which was awarded to the low final round in all boys divisions. Rounding out the top three was Ryan Triller of Street, MD who played consistent golf the entire weekend and posted consecutive rounds of 75 for a total of 150.

Although the weekend was full of great play, Jacob Stockl rose to the top of the pack to clinch his first win with the IJGT. Jacob finished second two weeks ago at The Architects Club and has come close to victory numerous times before. "It feels great to finally get the win. I knew I would need to shoot lights out to get the victory and make every putt." The hard work Jacob is putting in to his golf game is certainly paying off; "I have been working hard on improving my shot shaping, which has shown progress this weekend."

In the Boys 13-15 Division, two familiar competitors needed a playoff to decide the winner. Both Scott Jaster of Bryn Mawr, PA and Cody Cox of Milford, PA were tied after 36 holes with a total score of 145. On the first playoff hole, which took place on number 10, Scott stuck his approach shot and made the putt for par and first place honors. Scott has numerous



victories with the IJGT this season and is always a threat to win. Cody was a very deserving second place finisher and also won the low final round belt buckle with a score of 72. Coming in third place with rounds of 76 and 73 for a tournament total of 149 was Sean Fahey from Villanova, PA.



The Boys 12 & Under Division also featured low scores and brilliant shot making. With rounds of 78 and 73, Bennett Buch of Sykesville, MD reeled in his first IJGT tournament victory. This young star displayed nerves of steel and great touch around the greens during the two day event. Robert Diforio of White Plains, NY fired consecutive rounds of 78 to finish with a total of 156 and a second place finish. Walker Kirk was the leader after the first round with a score of 77 and carded an 81 on Sunday for a total of 158, which clinched the third place trophy.

The drama of the boy's divisions spilled over into the Girls 15-19 Division. 36 holes were not enough to settle the score and an extra playoff hole was necessary. August Kim of Searingtown, NY buried an 8 foot par putt to win the playoff and take home the first place trophy after rounds of 81 and 80 for a total of 161. Alexandra Hershberger of Basking Ridge, NJ was a very deserving second place finisher with rounds of 86 and 75 for a total of 161. Alexandra also earned the special 59 Belts buckle for shooting the lowest final round in all girls age divisions. Rounding out the top three was Christina Paulsen of Ridgewood, NJ with rounds of 82 and 80 for a total of 162.



The future stars of the IJGT were on display in the Girls 14 & Under Division over the weekend. Jane Hopkinson-Wood of Pottstown, PA shot eye popping rounds of 83 and 87 to grab first place honors. In second place, Katie Edelblut of New Hope, PA shot rounds of 96 and 92 for a tournament total of 188. Sarah Kokotajlo of Ewing, NJ fired rounds of 99 and 91 to finish with a total of 190 and the third place trophy.

Entering Sunday's final-round, players were looking to finish strong and receive the coveted IJGT Low Final Round Belt Buckle. As an added bonus, the lowest final round in each the Boys and Girls divisions was awarded the special 59 Belts buckle. This week's winners were: Boys 16-19 Division, Brandon Hartranft, 72. Boys 13-15 Division, Cody Cox, 72. Boys U-12 Division, Bennett Buch, 73. Girls 15-19 Division, Alexandra Hershberger, 75, Girls U-14 Division, Jane Hopkinson-Wood, 87.
