**Slawter Triumphant in Comeback Victory**  
*Glatt Victorious*

**Pottstown, PA** — Ravens Claw Golf Club was the site of this week's 36-hole International Junior Golf Tour (IJGT) event. The juniors battled it out in the Ravens Claw Classic, which provided plenty of daunting challenges and required delicate shot making. With temperatures in the 90's, the competitors used the high temperatures to heat up their golf game as many posted very impressive scores.



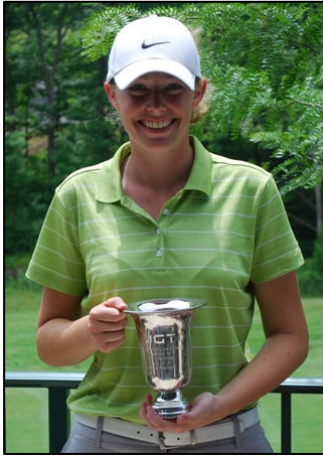
In the Boys 16-19 Division, Eric Slawter of Wayne, PA displayed stellar shot making and mental toughness throughout the entire tournament to earn the first place trophy. Eric fired a first round of 74 and was 2 strokes behind the leader entering Wednesday's final round. A final round 75 was enough to earn first place honors with a tournament total of 149. After the smoke cleared there was a tie for second place with a two-day total of 150. J. Harrison Brink II from Chambersburg, PA posted rounds of 76 and 74 while Andrew Feldman of Allentown, PA posted rounds of 77 and 73, both finishing one stroke behind the leader. Andrew Feldman also earned the popular low final round belt buckle.

Although the weekend was full of great play, Eric Slawter rose to the top of the pack to clinch his first win with the IJGT. "My ball striking was good both rounds. I think this course really suited my style of play because it is all about ball placement." When asked about his gameplan entering the final round, Eric replied "I just tried to hang around and keep the ball in play. I knew if I played my game I had a shot to win it."

There was no shortage of excitement in the Boys 13-15 Division, including a hole-in-one by Chester Springs, PA native Jon Stewart. Emerging from the crowded leader board was Brandon Matthews from Dupont, PA. Jon proved why he is one of the up and coming stars in junior golf with rounds of 69 and 68 to finish with a tournament total of five-under 137. The final round score of 68 was also enough for the low round belt buckle. Finishing in second place was Cape May Court



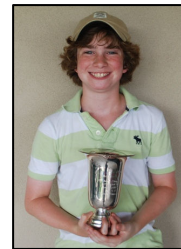
House, NJ native David Hicks after carding rounds of 78 and 77 for a total score of 155. The third place trophy was awarded to Jamie Cresswell of Schuylkill Haven, PA after he fired rounds of 76 and 84 for a total of 160.



In the Girls 15-19 Division, Jordan Glatt of Doylestown, PA had a hot hand throughout the entire tournament. After a first round score of 79, Jordan was the leader heading into the final round. Jordan never allowed the rest of the field to catch her as she fired a 78 in the final round for a tournament total of 157. This was Jordan's second win with the IJGT and credited her victory to her improved short game. "My play around the greens was the key to playing well the past couple days... I just try to shoot my best when I'm out there." Jordan's final round score of 78 also earned her the low round belt buckle. Francesca Ruscio of Jamison, PA earned a second place finish after two solid rounds of 80 and 89 for a tournament total of 169. Caroline Sawin from Haverford, PA rounded out the top three with rounds of 83 and 89 for a total score of 172.



The future stars of the IJGT were on display in the Girls 14 & Under Division and the Boys 12 & Under Division over the weekend. In the Girls 14 & Under Division, Jane Hopkinson-wood shot rounds of 91 and 86 to grab first place honors. In the Boys 12 & Under Division, Stephen Cerbara of Langhorne, PA played consistent golf both days by firing rounds of 79 and 83 for a two-day total of 162 and a first place finish. With rounds of 103 and 100, David



Desatnick of St. Davids, PA displayed great determination and finished in second place.

Entering Sunday's final-round, players were looking to finish strong and receive the coveted IJGT Low Final Round Belt Buckle. This week's winners were: Boys 16-19 Division, Andrew Feldman, 73. Boys 13-15 Division, Brandon Matthews, 68. Boys U-12 Division, Stephen Cerbara, 83. Girls 15-19 Division, Jordan Glatt, 78. Girls U-14 Division, Jane Hopkinson-wood, 86.
