**WEBBE WINS WIRE-TO-WIRE  
*Spiranac Ties Course Record On Way to Victory***

**Tempe, AZ** — The International Junior Golf Tour (IJGT) completed its first weekend in May at the Arizona State University (ASU) Karsten Golf Course in Tempe, AZ. The ASU Karsten Golf Course is a classic Pete Dye, links-style course set in the shadows of ASU's Sun Devil Stadium. Top PGA Tour professionals call this course home, including Billy Mayfair, Jeff Quinney, and Phil Mickelson. The IJGT was blessed with ideal weather all weekend which lead to some very competitive rounds, and many low scores.

Hank Haney International Junior Golf Academy (HH IJGA) student and North Vancouver, Canada native Daniel Webbe came out on top Sunday afternoon. After firing an even par 70 in round one, no one could catch Webbe. He credits his victory to his consistent putting, having to roll in many key putts throughout the weekend. Webbe said he had to scramble many times throughout the weekend but was able to come through in the clutch with his putter. Webbe was able to finish strong by making a key par save on No. 16 followed by a birdie on the par-5 17<sup>th</sup>. Finishing in a four-way tie for second place honors was Jake Stonich of Irvine, CA, Douglas Head of Temecula, CA, Trace Libby of Glendale, AZ, and Ed Fenwick of York, United Kingdom. All four competitors finished the tournament at 145.

In the Boys 13-15 Division Michael Moorhead Jr. of Newport Beach, CA fired rounds of 75 and 73 for a tournament total of 148 and first place honors. Moorhead bested his first-round score by two shots to fend off the charging competition and win by a total of five strokes. Taking home second place honors was Daeyeob Chae of Chandler, AZ with rounds of 76 and 77 for a tournament total of 153. Rounding out the top three was Jonathan Keedy and John Davenport, both of Newport Beach, CA with matching rounds of 81 and 82, for a 163 weekend total.

Andrew Morgan of Long Beach, CA was victorious in the Boys 12 & Under Division by following up his first-round 74 with a final-round 72. Morgan started the final round with a six stroke lead and never looked back en route to his ninth win on the season. Finishing in second place was Blake Meek of Pasadena, CA who fired an impressive final-round 74. Rounding out the top three was JJ Qualkenbush of Lahaina, HI with rounds of 80 and 81 for a tournament total of 161.

In the Girls 19 & Under Division, Paige Spiranac of Monument, CO was crowned the victor. Spiranac's near perfect round on Saturday led to a spot in the history books. Her five-under par 65 tied the course record from the Women's Tees and gave her a commanding lead in an extremely competitive division. She continued her stellar play with a final-round 72 to finish the two-day event at a three-under par 137 total and 12 shot victory. Coming in second place was Lauren Salazar of Santa Clara, CA with rounds of 75 and 74, respectively. Finishing alone in third place was Ashleigh Albrecht of Murrieta, CA who carded a tournament total of 154.
