**Vandeventer Dominates Final Round  
Impressive Win by Liu**

**Tempe, AZ** — The International Junior Golf Tour (IJGT) completed its first weekend in February at ASU Karsten Golf Course in Tempe, AZ. The ASU Karsten Golf Course is a classic Pete Dye, links-style course set in the shadows of ASU's Sun Devil Stadium. Top PGA Tour professionals call this course home, including Billy Mayfair, Jeff Quinney, and Phil Mickelson. The IJGT was blessed with fair weather all weekend which lead to some very competitive rounds, and many low scores.

Jay Vandeventer of Bristol, VA ran away with the Boys 13-19 Division by shooting seven under par for the tournament. Vandeventer came out on fire on Saturday shooting the low round of the weekend with a 68. He followed that performance up on Sunday by firing a 69 giving him first place honors. Also going under par for the tournament was Samuel Chavez of Hillsborough, CA. Chavez's two-day total of 141, three under par, gave him a second place finish. It was a tight race for third place in this division with Austyn Karle of Scottsdale, AZ having the slight edge coming into the second day of competition. However, Ricky McDonald of Seattle, WA finished tied with Karle for third after he carded an excellent round of 69 on the final day.

Dylan Healey of Albuquerque, NM fired consistent rounds of 74 & 76 to win the Boys 12 & Under Division. Taking home the second place trophy was Jonathan Keedy of Newport Beach, CA who posted rounds of 83 and 80 for a 163 total. Rounding out the division was David Jang of Alea, HI carding a two-round total of 188.

In the Girls 19 & Under Division, Shu-Yin Liu of Tualatin, OR was the leader coming into the final round sitting at one under par. Liu matched her first score of 71 on Sunday, giving her a tournament total 142 and the first place victory. Daffodil Sanchez of Mesa, AZ, and Kaira Martin of Paradise Valley, were separated by just one stroke heading into Sunday. Sanchez shot just one over par, giving her a two-day total of 148 which was enough to give her a second place finish. Martin came up just a little short but still finished strong in third place. The shot of the day came out of this division on Sunday, as Lauren Mata of Palm Desert, CA Aced #6, a 151 yard par three. "I was very excited, it was my first hole-in-one," Mata explained when asked how she felt about it. "I saw it rolling towards the hole, and I thought it had a chance to go in." We at the IJGT congratulate Lauren on this once in a lifetime accomplishment.
