**International Junior Golf Tour (IJGT) Presents
Wachovia International at Colleton River
Bluffton, SC
Monday, January 21, 2008**

**Winther Finishes Strong
Sogaard Cruises
Wendt Leapfrogs
Long Dominates**

Bluffton, SC — The final round of the International Junior Golf Tour's Wachovia International at Colleton River Plantation concluded Monday afternoon. The 54-hole event was played for two rounds on the Jack Nicklaus Course and one round on the Pete Dye Course. Both courses have been recognized by *Golf Magazine* as one of the 100 greatest courses in the United States respectively. With less than desirable weather, the players were still able to put up some impressive numbers.

The Boys 16-19 Division proved to be competitive once again this weekend. International Junior Golf Academy (IJGA) student Patrick Winther of Solleroed, Denmark finished strong on the final day posting an even par 72. Despite wet and cold conditions, his four-under par 68 on Saturday proved to be the low round of the tournament. It also was the difference maker in his down to the wire win over fellow IJGA student Davis Lee. Winther, the 4th ranked 2010 graduate by *GolfWeek Magazine*, won his fourth title of the season on the 2007-2008 IJGT circuit. Lee's impressive play during the final round including four birdies and an eagle as he finished the day with a 1-over par 73 and a 222 tournament total. Finishing in a tie for third place was Gregor Orlando of Erie, PA and Sebastian Szirmak of Toronto, Ontario, Canada with tournament totals of 227.

It was a tight race heading into the final round in the Boys 13-15 Division. When it was all said and done Mads Sogaard (IJGA) of Ikast, Denmark came out victorious. Sogaard was two shots behind second-round leader Andrew Stevenson (IJGA) of Dublin, Ireland, when he fired an impressive even-par 72 on Monday to post a tournament total 220 and come away with a three-shot victory. Stevenson finished in second place with a three-day total of 223. Finishing tied for third place was Jason Roets (IJGA) of Eikenhof, South Africa and Alex Ehlert of Raleigh, NC. Roets fired the low round of the division with a three-under par 69 on Monday, while Ehlert's consistent play led to a weekend total of 229.

In the Boys 12 & Under Division, Wesley Long of Bluffton, SC proved to be the victor after defeating his nearest competitor by an impressive 13 strokes. Long posted a final round four-over par 76 for a tournament total 232. Long birdied the par four 18th hole to card a one over par 37 on the back nine. Finishing in second place was Christian Whitehead of Lexington, SC after shooting a superb final round 77. Rounding out the top three was Theo Humphrey of Greenwich, CT with a tournament total of 249.

In the Girls 19 & Under Division, the IJGA dominated the leaderboard as Elizabeth Wendt (IJGA) of Houston, TX came away with the victory after trailing fellow competitor Airielle Dawson (IJGA) of Mitchellville, MD. Wendt fired a final round 79 to finish with a tournament total 242 and a three-stroke win. Dawson finished in second place with a tournament total of 245. Rounding out the top three was Kelly Miller (IJGA) of Ceredigion, United Kingdom.
